<u>BASEBALL AGE DETERMINATION DATE</u>: All baseball divisions League Determination Age is **age on August 31, 2026. SOFTBALL AGE DETERMINATION DATE:** All softball divisions League Determination Age is age on **December 31, 2025** 

<u>Please read carefully:</u> North Oldham Little League Boundary Map and Little League Baseball League Finder link is on our website(please check) to find which group of the three below you are in. All players in residence or school boundary(Group 1 or 2) must provide the proofs for that group. For all outside boundary players(Group 3), Ages 4-7 has no restrictions playing at North Oldham Little League still must turn in their proof of residence for group 1 or 2 below. For all players ages 8-12 they should provide proofs of residence from Group 1 or 2 and provide a waiver request. If a player received a waiver approval in the past no need for another request.

- 1. Residence Boundary: All players that live in our league boundaries must provide 3 proofs of residence (Drivers License, utility bill, vehicle registration with a date between 2/1/25 to 2/1/26 marked on the proof or if they attend the following schools Buckner, Centerfield, LaGrange, Locust Grove, EOMS, and OCMS you must provide a school enrollment form(on website). Home School players must live in league boundaries 2. School Boundary: If a player lives inside or outside the league boundary but attends one of the following schools, Buckner, Centerfield, LaGrange, Locust Grove, EOMS and OCMS, you must provide a school enrollment form(on website) as their proof or residence. All Home School players that reside in league boundaries must provide 3 proofs of residence
- 3. Out of League Boundary: For all outside boundary players, Ages 4-7 has no restrictions playing at North Oldham Little League still must turn in their proof of residence for group 1 or 2 below. For all players ages 8-12 they should provide proofs of residence from Group 1 or 2 and provide a waiver request. If a player received a waiver approval in the past no need for another request.

<u>VOLUNTEERS:</u> All adults needs to fill out Volunteer Application on our website if you plan on volunteering in our league. As the league continues to have good success, we still need to have good volunteers in the league. We always have trouble finding enough good managers for some of the divisions. Especially in the younger divisions. So, please step up. All volunteers will have a background check done on them which is required by Little League Baseball. If you are interested, please fill out volunteer application on line and have a copy of your driver's license attached to it. There is a lot of areas you can volunteer for, Manager, coach, helping at tryouts, helping at the concession stand, field maintenance, scorekeeper, team parent, helping on Opening Day and umpiring All Volunteers interested in being a manager or coach must have their applications turn in by February 1<sup>st</sup>, 2026. Please make sure put your complete full name and social security number on application

<u>OPENING DAY & PARADE</u>: The 2026 season will get under way on Monday, April 13<sup>th</sup> with the Opening Day Parade and Breakfast on Saturday, April 18th. The parade will start at 8:45am at the LaGrange Fire Department. All players and coaches must meet at 8:15am to line up for the parade. The parade will start on time. Parents are welcomed to walk with the players. The LaGrange Fire Department will have a breakfast starting at 7:00am. Please make every effort to attend this event rain or shine. The season will end on June 22<sup>nd</sup>. Game schedules will be out by March 22<sup>nd</sup>. Player Uniforms will be handed out after March 22<sup>nd</sup>

**TRYOUTS:** All baseball and softball players must attend the tryout session on Saturday - February 21<sup>st</sup> at LaGrange Elementary School Gym. (500 W. Jefferson Street LaGrange). Parking available behind Gym. Those players who do not attend the tryouts will be assigned randomly to teams on draft day. The draft will be held the very next day after the tryouts. All players must check in when they tryout. **No Cleats allowed** Tryouts are divided by division and the first initial of the player's last name. Please check times below and please follow it. Player may attend another time slot if needed in their division. All players should hear from their manager by February 24<sup>th</sup>. Rosters will be posted at our web site. Practices will start on February 28<sup>th</sup> weather permitting. 6 Year Olds may play up in Rookie divisions if capable they must attend tryouts.

**NO SMOKING ALLOWED:** There is no smoking allowed (including electronic cigarettes) in the baseball complex area at Walsh Park . If you would like to smoke go to the parking lot or the other side of the parking lot. You will be asked to leave the complex with your player if you can't follow the rules.

<u>PETS & PARKING:</u> No pets are allowed at the ballfields during all practices and all games. Please tell the grandparents and other relatives about this policy. If the pet is brought they will be asked to remove the pet. Service dogs are allowed but must have their vest on. Extra parking will be at Immaculate Conception Church parking lot. Please do not park in the first three rows closest to the church on days that they have church service. Please watch your speed and pickup your trash.

EQUIPMENT REQUIUREMENTS: All male players must have athletic supporter. All players are required to have their own glove, batting helmet, bat and cleats for rookie, minor and major division players(ages 7-12). Coach-Pitch and T-Ball can wear tennis shoes. Softball player facemask is optional, all Write players name on all equipment if possible, All baseball bats must have a USA Bat label on it. Does not included softball bats. Any use of an illegal bat during a game baseball or softball will result of the player and the manger being removed from the game and will miss the next scheduled game as well. If player has their own catching equipment the catcher's mask must have the dangling throat protector. Batting helmets can not be spray painted or have decals. Practice with your children at home Make sure your child has everything before you leave the park or the practice area. Keep the kids from throwing balls against the dugouts and the signs. Keep the kids from throwing rocks at the park.
